



## Steven Lawrence Blount

June 12, 1949 - December 11, 2007

Steven Lawrence Blount, age 58, was born in San Antonio, Texas on June 12, 1949 and passed away at M. D. Anderson Hospital in Houston, Texas on December 8, 2007 after a lengthy illness. Steve retired from Celanese Chemical Research Center in Corpus Christi, Texas in 2003. He was an avid hunter who traveled often to Canada for hunts.
