



## Sue Walker Oliver Mills

March 31, 1930 - May 1, 2025

Sue Walker Oliver Mills was born in Anson, Texas to Jack Andrew Walker and Ida Austin Walker. Mrs. Mills was preceded in death by her parents: first husband, Donald Lee Oliver, her daughter Donna Sue Oliver, two older brothers, Dr. Jack A. Walker and Daniel A. Walker (a Marine who was killed on Iwo Jima during World War II) and sister Ann Hollingsworth. Sue's second husband Dr. Ralph L. Mills died March 8, 2016. She is survived by her daughter Dottie Ann Martin; grandsons Austin Martin and wife Sara, and Andrew Martin, great-grandsons Max Austin Martin and Rex Wayne Martin, stepdaughters Patricia Ann Mills, Linda Sue Ruff (Steve), step grandson Eric Ruff and many nieces and nephews.

After college, mostly at the University of Texas, Sue Mills trained as a Medical Technologist at the University of Texas Medical Branch in Galveston where she passed her National Exam for the American Society of Clinical Pathologists. She continued as a Medical Technologist at UTMB for the rest of her career until moving to Elkins Lake in 1990, where she lived for the remainder of her life. She was a member of Elkins Lake Baptist Church. Graveside services will be held on Friday, May 9, 2025, at Forest Park East Cemetery in Webster, Texas at 3:30 PM.
