



Susan Spurlock Wilkins

March 1, 1922 - July 1, 2014

Susan Wilkins, formerly of Huntsville, Texas, died July 1, 2014, while visiting her daughter in Maryland. Mrs. Wilkins was born Susan Laura Spurlock on March 1, 1922, in Macon, Georgia. Following graduation from Agnes Scott College in Decatur, Georgia, in 1943, Mrs. Wilkins married Leonard Wilkins, and the young couple moved to Beaver, Pennsylvania, where they raised their family.

Susan and Leonard lived abroad on several occasions due to Mr. Wilkins' chemical engineering assignments, including Brazil, England, and Canada, and finally settled in Huntsville, Texas, where they enjoyed many great friends in the Elkins Lake community. After Mr. Wilkins' death in 2001, Mrs. Wilkins moved to the Summit at Westlake Hills in Austin, Texas, to be closer to her son. She was known at the Summit as a wonderful organizer – sponsoring a quilting festival, establishing a lending library of jigsaw puzzles throughout the senior living center, serving as a guest speaker to recount her tales of living abroad, and participating enthusiastically in many book reviews. In March 2012, she celebrated her 90th birthday with many friends from the Summit and beyond.

Mrs. Wilkins was preceded in death by her husband, Leonard, and by her daughter, Christina Lynne Wilkins Fulmer. She is survived by her son, Robert Leonard Wilkins of Round Rock, Texas, her daughter, Mareta Wilkins

Chambers of Dayton, Maryland, and by two grandchildren, Andrew Chambers and Rebecca Tribbey, and 6 great-grandchildren. She is already sorely missed by her friends and family.

A graveside service at the Huntsville Cemetery, Mayes Addition, will be conducted at 1:00 PM on Tuesday, July 8, 2014.
