The daughter of the late Earl and Ruth Schlegelmilch, Suzy was born on January 19, 1948, in Norman, Oklahoma. She was preceded in death by her brother "Bud". Suzy graduated from LaMarque High School in 1966 and earned a B.S. degree in math from the University of Texas in 1970. Additionally, she attained a master's degree in education from the University of Houston in 1974. She taught mathematics in the public schools of Texas for 36 years at Seabrook High School, Clear Lake High School, Austin Westlake High School, Dobie High School, Edinburg High School, Conroe High School, and Huntsville High School. Throughout her career, Suzy was highly respected by her students, and loved by her fellow teachers. She was a mentor to numerous student teachers. When she retired, Suzy enjoyed traveling to places such as Alaska, Canada, and Costa Rica with her friends. She had a special fondness for pets, and often took in abandoned cats. Her hobbies included gardening, crossword puzzles, and bridge with her friends.
