In Matthew 3 verse 1-6 Jesus had three emotional reactions toward this

situation. The first was compassion to save this man suffering and ostracism. Jesus' use of "to save life or to kill" could be expanded "to save from danger, loss, and destruction, or to destroy either physically or morally, to deprive of spiritual life leading to eternal misery in hell," maybe implying there was more at stake for this man than they knew from their limited viewpoint. The second reaction was anger, which in Greek means not an outburst of wrath, but as a state of mind. This is the only place in the Gospels where this word is used to describe Jesus. It is interesting that Aristotle said that this type of anger "is desire with grief," for Jesus' anger soon turned to grief, which means to be afflicted, grieved for another person, similar to the Greek word for sympathy, to feel pain together with another. These men were on thin ice with Jesus, but we see that He chose to show grief and sorrow over their hardened hearts as He looked right through them, silencing them. So, goodnight my wife, my mother, my Nina, and my sister, we have all three emotions: compassion, anger, and grief for you. With all our LOVE may your soul rest in peace and harmony with our Lord and Savior. Tammie is survived by her husband, Troy Reinstein, her daughters Amber Kowalski and her husband Kai Kowalski of Kerrville, Texas; and Melody Gathright and her husband, Daniel Gathright, and grandson, Weston Gathright of Huntsville, Texas; sister, Belinda McGaughy and husband, Alan McGaughy of Friendswood, Texas. Tammie was predeceased by her beloved mother, Carolyn Walker and her father, Clarence Emmons, Jr. A memorial service will be held Saturday, August 24, 2013, 2:00 p.m., at Sam Houston Memorial Funeral Home Chapel, Huntsville, Texas with Pastor Richard Rogers officiating.
