Terry Sapp Terry was born on February 11, 1965, in Nuremberg, Germany, to Allen Sapp, Sr. and Patricia Barber Sapp. He passed away on December 13, 2012, in Huntsville, Texas. He was 47 years old. Terry led an active life full of smiles, fun and energy. He always enjoyed the outdoors, working on cars, barbecuing and visiting with friends. Terry served six years in the U.S. Air Force and following his honorable discharge from the service entered a career in law enforcement and criminal justice. He served a number of years as a Deputy Sheriff in Johnson County, Missouri, before moving to Huntsville to join the Texas Department of Criminal Justice. He worked at the Ellis, Polunsky and Byrd Units over the next twelve years and made many life-long friends among his co-workers. Terry later left TDCJ to pursue work in the oil and gas industry where he prospered for several years until health issues finally forced him to retire.
