



## Dr. Terry Sprott Wood

July 21, 1950 - July 18, 2016

Dr. Terry Sprott Wood, age 65, died July 18, 2016 in Liberty, Texas, following a long illness. Born July 21, 1950 in Houston, Texas, he was a 1968 graduate of Huntsville High School. He then obtained both his Bachelor of Science and Master's of Science degrees at Sam Houston State University. Relocating to San Antonio, Texas, he earned his degree in general dentistry together with a Master's degree in Periodontal Surgery at the University of Texas Health Science Center. He then returned to the Houston area where he practiced periodontics for many years until illness forced his retirement. He lived at Lake Conroe and loved to boat, fish and Bar-B-Q.

He is survived by four children, Christopher Wood, Nicholas Wood, Joshua Wood and Sabryn A. Wood; his brother, Michael "Mike" Wood; and numerous other relatives and friends. He is preceded in death by his parents Walter Curtis Wood and LaVerne Milligan Wood.

A memorial service will be held at 2:00 PM on Saturday, July 23, 2016 in the chapel at Sam Houston Memorial Funeral Home in Huntsville, Texas.
