Thomas James Martin, age 75 of Montgomery, Texas passed away peacefully surrounded by family on Wednesday September 6th, 2023. Tom was born in Wheeling, West Virginia on June 2 1948, the son of Roy William Martin and Helen Simoncic Martin.

At the age of 11, Tom moved to Japan for one and a half years while his father was working there for IBM. They returned to Canfield, Ohio where Tom graduated from Canfield High School in 1966. Following his graduation, Tom received his Associates Degree in Accounting from Youngstown College of Business.

On June 27, 1970 he married Janet Schromofsky and resided in Struthers, Ohio. Tom began his career with Dow Chemical In 1975. Later, he transferred to the Schlumberger oilfield division.
