



## Thomas Steven Price

October 23, 1953 - July 24, 2014

Thomas S. Price, a man with deep roots in Montgomery, left this earthly life Saturday morning July 19, 2014 doing something he loved; visiting over breakfast with family and friends and then riding out to greet the day and its possibilities. Tom was a much loved husband, father, son, brother and best of all, grandfather. He was born on October 23, 1953, the middle son of James E. Price and Joyce Ann Martin Price. He is preceded in death by his father James E. Price. Tom grew up as had several generations of Prices before him, exploring the hills and creeks of the family farm with his two brothers, Jimmy and David, aided by a constant flow of cousins from both the Price and Martin extended families. Childhood days filled with adventure checked by the loose rein of quite a community of older relatives and friends. What better way to learn about history and family tradition than helping Aunt Bessie Price Owen search for arrowheads or listening to the stories told around the fire in the evening by older members of the family and friends? Stories of pioneer hardship, wild cow hunting, and witty creations of humor and earthiness. From such a beginning he developed a deep appreciation of history, archeology, and human nature. Tom and his brothers were kept busy as they grew by many members of this extended family; learning to handle cattle, build fences, and run farm machinery and in so doing learned much about human and animal behaviour-all of which could become fodder for a good story. By the time he graduated from Montgomery High School in 1972, he already had a start on skills in the building trades which would serve him the rest of his life

working for himself. In September of 1975 Tom married Holly Sue Underwood of Conroe and together they built a house on the family farm in which to raise their three children. As his family grew and his work area expanded, so did his love of the Texas Hill country. Ultimately he was able to develop another home in Sisterdale near his much loved grandchildren. This was a man who can be measured by the relationships he nurtured; he was someone who was always willing to put down what he was doing to help someone else. A father and grandfather who gave the greatest gift to his children-that of time-taking great joy in just spending time doing simple things that children love and in the process leaving wonderful memories for them to cherish. He leaves behind his wife, Holly, their three children and families; Zachary and wife Shanna -and sons Jaxon and Hunter; Emiley Beth Price Goulet and husband Ed and daughter Layla Weaks; and daughter Jacy Suzanne Price and partner Heather. His mother Joyce Ann Martin Price, His older brother, James M. (Jimmy) and wife Donna and their children and families Cole and Brandy Price, Kelly Price, and Cade M. Price. Younger brother David O.
