



Thomas Ray Warren Sr

May 23, 1925 - July 10, 2018

Ray Warren passed away on July 10, 2018 at the age of 93. He was born on May 23, 1925 in Riverside, Texas. Ray grew up in the Riverside community north of Huntsville, Texas. He attended the Riverside Public School through the 10th grade. He transferred to Huntsville High School and graduated in 1943. Ray served in the Army from 1943 to 1945. After leaving the Army, Ray returned to the state of Texas. Ray was hired by Sam Houston State University to be the farm manager of Country Campus Ranch in 1956. He retired from the farm in 1991 after 35 years of service.

Ray was one of the founding members of Country Campus Baptist Church and was a deacon in the church. He had a great impact on several of the farm boys that worked at Country Campus and they attended church with him often. Ray enjoyed fishing, hunting, and spending time with his family and friends.

Ray is survived by his son, Thomas Ray Warren Jr., daughter-in-law Rachel Warren, granddaughters Emily Warren and Allie Warren, granddaughter Becky McMillan (Lonnie), great granddaughter Macy McMillan from Tupelo, MS, step-granddaughter Michelle Hale (JJ) and their son Tye, from Myrtle, MS. Ray is also survived by his sister, Grace Minick from Riverside, Texas. He is preceded in death by his father and mother Scott and Nellie Warren, wife Coretha Warren, and daughters Cindy Lou and Sally Warren.

He will be greatly missed by family and friends.

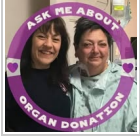
