He enjoyed playing with the MOB at Bentwater. He has served in the past as President of the Men's Golf Association at Bentwater. Mr. Woods proudly served in the US Air Force from July, 1948 to April, 1957. He attended Oklahoma University from 1957 to 1960 and received a Bachelor of Mechanical Engineering degree. He was an avid OU fan. Mr. Woods retired from Halliburton Services as Executive Vice-President in 1996. After retirement Tom and Elisabeth enjoyed traveling all over the US and Canada in their motor home. He was a good provider as well as a mentor to his family.
