Travis Eugene Carrothers, 52, of Mulvane, KS passed away unexpectedly on Thursday, February 3, 2022.

Travis was born at St. Luke's Hospital in Wellington, KS on April 4, 1969 to Roy A. and Judith A. Carrothers. He is survived by his parents Roy A. Carrothers of Vian, OK and Judith (Carrothers) Garrett of Montgomery, TX, brother Troy A. Carrothers of Mequon, WI, half-sister Tayler H.
