At various times, she worked as an office nurse, an ENT and allergy nurse, an allergy and immunology nurse, a pediatric nurse, a family practice nurse, and an internal medicine nurse. Vicki particularly enjoyed the many weekends she spent with the Hash House Harriers, where she had many close friends. She had a personality that lit up a room, and she is sorely missed. A graveside service will be held at 11:00 a.m. on Friday, October 17th, at Forest Park Westheimer Cemetery, Westheimer Rd. at Dairy Ashford Rd., in Houston, with Dr. Jerry Neff of the First United Methodist Church of Conroe officiating.
