Weldon Everett Matthys passed into God's arms peacefully on Thursday, May 3, 2018 after a short illness.

He is preceded in Heaven by his loving wife, Betty, after 56 beautiful years together, as well as his parents, John Fred and Alma Finley Matthys. Weldon was born on August 17, 1937 in Wharton, Texas, he lived 80 blessed years, making many happy memories and touching countless lives. Weldon is survived by his four brothers; Donald, Sherman, William, and Larry Matthys, his two sisters; Dorothy Malcom and Carol Koenig, his five loving children & spouses; Sharon and Joe Mattingly, Derek and Sheila Matthys, Bryan and Christina Matthys, Valerie and Dave Morel, and Suzette and Gerald Kohers; 13 wonderful grandchildren, 3 great-grandchildren, and many faithful friends.

Weldon proudly served his country in the US Navy as a Communications Technician, stationed in San Diego, California from 1955 to 1959. After the Navy he worked as a mail carrier, walking his route in his beloved home town of Wharton for several years. Weldon and Betty were married June 13, 1959 and together with their children moved to Huntsville, Texas in 1970. He then attended and studied at Sam Houston State University, graduating in 1971. Later making a career as the Assistant Director of Computer Services for the university until his retirement in 1998, though he continued to be an avid Bearkat fan and a loyal SHSU Alumni Member. He loved being a part of his

community, serving in the Huntsville Kiwanis Club for 12 years as Secretary, Vice President, and then President.

Weldon Matthys lived a life lead by faith, setting an shining example of a strong Godly man, husband, and father. He and his family have been active members of First United Methodist Church of Huntsville for 48 years, where he gladly served as an usher for 40 of those years.
