William Clint Adams William Clint Adams, known to many former students of Huntsville High School as “Hardhat” died Sunday, January 1, 2006. He was born in Lovelady, Texas, October 10, 1920 to Alver Adams and wife, Carrie Flournoy Adams, the second of nine children. He is preceded in death by his parents, son Bud Adams, three brothers and one sister. Clint proudly served four years in WWII with the 457th. Bomber Group, 8th Air Force, 1st Division, 94th Bomber Wing and flew 30 sorties over Germany as chief engineer and top turret gunner of a B17. After his discharge he attended the University of Houston and then was in various retail businesses. After returning to Huntsville he worked for several years as security for Huntsville High School, where he was given the name “Hardhat” by the students. Clint just recently received his 60 year pin from the Masonic Lodge, he was a life member of the Eastern Star and a member of University Heights Baptist Church. He and his wife Eunice celebrated their 50th. anniversary in March, 2005. Clint is survived by his wife, Eunice, of Huntsville, grandson, Markus Clint Adams, Miami, FL, great grandchildren, Taylor, Marshall and Raegan Adams, daughter-in-law, Betty Salvans, Ft.
