William (Bill) R. Fallin, Jr. passed away of natural causes on March 18, 2011 at the age of 89. Bill was born on October 7 1921 to parents William and Eula Fallin. He was preceded in death by his parents and first wife Dorothy Alaniva Fallin. Bill was a member of the 31st Bombardment Squadron of the 5th Bombardment Group and recipient of the Distinguished Flying Cross. After enlisting in the Army Air Corps on January 28, 1942 he quickly worked his

way up to Major and was a distinguished leader of B-24 Liberator long distance bomber squadrons, receiving 10 air medals while flying 46 missions in the Pacific Theatre. Bill was an avid golfer, member of the San Angelo Country Club and Elkins Lake Country Club. An accomplished player of many logic based games including 42, spades, and bridge. An active Member of UHBC and served in many capacities including Adult Men's Sunday School Teacher, and volunteered for Good Sheppard Mission for many years. Bill attended two years at Texas A&M before WW II. A friendly rivalry ensued when his three sons graduate from the University of Texas and a nephew and grandson graduated from Texas A&M.

Bill lived in Jacksonville Tx, Farmington NM, Midland Tx, San Angelo Tx, Huntsville Tx, and briefly in Richardson Tx.; was a data processor for Great Western Petroleum, City of San Angelo Data Manager; Owner Manager of Mark's Bar-B-Q, Data Manager of Nash Construction; and Data Manager of Capro. After retirement in 1994 he devoted more time to his precious family, volunteering and golfing.
