



William Posey Parsons

November 25, 1949 - December 23, 2022

William “Bill” Parsons entered eternal life surrounded by his family after a brief illness. He and Kim were united in holy matrimony in 1976 and this union was blessed with 3 children. His life will forever be cherished by his sons, Jason Parsons, wife Marissa and son Isaac; Jeff Parsons, wife Abby and son Bryce; and daughter Sissy Scholl, husband Kelly, children Hunter and Rylie. Bill is also survived by 4 brothers, Eddie, Bob, Dave and Mike Parsons and multiple nieces, nephews and “outlaws.”

He was preceded in death by his parents, Eddie and Mary Alice Parsons, his brothers Tom and Steve Parsons.

Born November 25th, 1949 in San Antonio, Texas and raised in the Houston West University area, Bill attended Catholic school and graduated from Marion High School in 1968. He later graduated from St. Thomas University with a Bachelors of Science in Economics in 1972. He then started working in the security department at Astroworld and a co-worker nicknamed him “The Reverend Parsons” which was later shortened to “Rev.” During the summer of 1974, he met the love of his life, Kim, who was working in guest relations at Astroworld. With Kim in Louisiana and Bill in Houston, their relationship quickly led to a May wedding in 1976. Bill moved to Lafayette and started working in the oil industry while Kim finished her last year of nursing school. A job transfer brought them back to Houston in 1978. While working in the oil

industry, he joined the Cy Fair Volunteer Fire Department and discovered his love for emergency medicine. After much determination, continuing his career, raising a family and volunteering at the fire department, he achieved his paramedic certification. In 1986, he pursued paramedicine full time in Montgomery County. After commuting from Cypress to Conroe for 7 years, the Parsons packed up and moved to Montgomery, Texas where he enjoyed the rest of his life.

He was employed by Montgomery County Hospital District for 36 years where co-workers became his EMS family. His EMS background led him to work for several companies which provided medical care at major concerts and local events. Kim even enjoyed “working” these events with Bill including Willie’s 4th of July picnic. Bill traveled to many countries on overseas medical flights transporting patients. After reflecting on his last month alive, Kim fully understood the indescribable connection and bond the MCHD family has. The Parsons family is truly overwhelmed by the love and support they continue to show.

Bill was fulfilled by giving back when he started teaching EMT and paramedic classes early in his career. After 36 years working in the field, he retired in 2009 and continued teaching classes. Many of his students went on to impact the communities they worked in and will forever remember his “war” stories related to his experiences as a paramedic.

His Catholic faith continued to be important to him all through his life. As a member of St. Mary’s Parish, Bill was active with the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults and went on to become a eucharistic minister. He proudly implemented the first aid program for the Fall Bazaar which led to the education of other groups in the Parish and will now be continued by Karen Kimmey.

Even though Bill would describe himself as “quiet, shy and reserved” his family and friends beg to differ. They will forever remember Bill by being a calm, yet witty storytelling man with no filter. There were many words that would come out of his mouth that no one understood and these were referred to as “Revisms.” With all Bill achieved, his greatest accomplishment was his ever growing family. Any time his grandchildren entered the room, he would light up with a smile that will always be remembered. He was proud to be called “Pops” and would stop whatever he was doing to play with his grands. He leaves a legacy that his family is proud to continue.

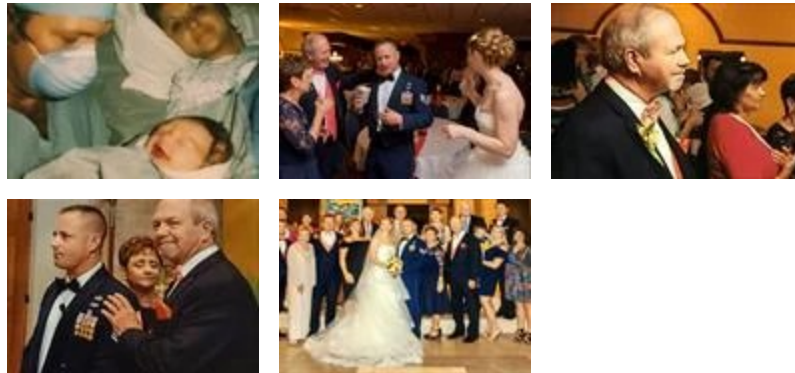
