After the war, he opened his own leather goods business, Pharr Shoe Repair and Western Wear. He was an active and well respected businessman in the the community for over 50 years. His civic developments include: Pharr Rotary Club, member of the Pharr Industrial Foundation, Director of the Hidalgo County Appraisal Review Board, Chairman of the Inter-American Council of Cities, past Director of the Pharr Chamber of Commerce, American Post Legion 101, McAllen Catholic War Veterans, President of the Helping Hands Club, member of the Pharr-Reynosa International Bridge Board, he was also an advisor to Pharr Vocational Schools, served as Director of Crippled Children and Adult Treatment Center.
